





KX3 Basics

- 160-6 meters
- SSB/CW/AM/FM/DATA
- 10 W+ (100 W+ with companion amp)
- Optional internal ATU, 8-cell battery pack with NiMH charger, attached paddle
- Built-in speaker

SDR (with a twist)

- NR, NB, notch, dual watch, stereo effects
- Receive I/Q outputs for SDR/PC apps




Ultra Portable/Mobile
